The following agreement constitutes a binding contract between Grundy's Canines, hereafter referred to as "Breeder", and "Purchaser", identified and described above under Purchaser Information, hereafter referred to as "Purchaser", for the sale and purchase of one puppy or dog identified and described above under Puppy Information, hereafter referred to as "Puppy". In consideration of a purchaser price of of which is a non-refundable deposit, Breeder agrees to transfer all rights, privileges and responsibilities associated with the ownership of a Puppy to Purchaser after Puppy has reached the age of 8 weeks. This represents the entire agreement between Breeder and Purchaser in an outright sale and payment is to be made in full before Puppy leaves Breeder's premises.

Health Guarantee

Breeder warrants Puppy to be in good health and free from illness at the time of transfer to Purchaser. Puppy will stay with Breeder until 8 weeks of age or deemed ready by breeder. Puppy will have at least one examination by a qualified veterinarian and will receive appropriate worming and vaccinations at Breeder's expense. Breeder requires Purchaser to have Puppy examined by a veterinarian of Purchaser's choice within **72 hours** of transfer of Puppy at Purchaser's expense or the health guaranteed portion of this contract will be null and void. In the event of emergency of any genetic or congenital disorder with the Puppy's first 6 months of life which is sufficiently serious in the opinion of at least two qualified veterinarians, one of whom will be selected by Breeder, to deem Puppy unsuitable as a companion pet or to warrant euthanasia of Puppy, Breeder agrees to:

- A. Replace Puppy with one of equivalent quality within 18 months or at Breeder's option,
- B. Refund the original purchase price.

In either of these cases, Puppy must be relinquished to Breeder for placement in a suitable home or euthanized at Breeder's expense if deemed necessary. Return shipping, veterinary and testing expenses and shipping costs associated with replacement Puppy are the responsibility of Purchaser. If Purchaser chooses to keep defective Puppy, Breeder will refund 25% of the purchase price that was originally paid for Puppy and listed on this contract. The 25% refund applies only to the purchase price and does not include veterinary or shipping costs. Choosing this option deems the health guarantee portion of this contract null and void. Purchaser must, in any of these circumstances, willingly and openly provide documentation of tests performed, supporting veterinary reports and veterinarian contact information to Breeder at Breeder's request. Purchaser understands that allowing puppy to become overweight, over-vaccination and failure to provide puppy with adequate diet, exercise, proper veterinary care and protection from hazards to the health and development of Puppy will deem the health guarantee portion of this contract null and void. Death due to injury, accident, owner neglect or any other cause will not be eligible for a refund. Breeder is not responsible for injuries sustained, illnesses contracted or death during transportation.

Owner Responsibilities

Purchaser agrees to maintain Puppy in a humane environment with ample shelter, a healthy diet, fresh water, exercise, human interaction and to properly train and care for Puppy. Puppy must not be over-vaccinated according to current vaccination guidelines. Puppy will not be allowed to roam and will be socialized and obedience trained appropriately. Breeder cautions Purchaser that dogs are intelligent animals that require stimulation, attention and consistent training and socialization opportunities. Breeder encourages Purchaser to provide appropriate opportunities for socialization with children, other dogs and strangers. If at any point in Puppy's life Purchaser is no longer able to care for Puppy, Puppy must at the time be returned to Breeder or re homed with Breeder's approval. Breeder is not required to compensate Purchaser for Puppy's expenses or purchase price when the puppy is returned. Purchaser may not sell Puppy without Breeder's approval.
